2. General Information on Data Processing

We take the protection of your personal data very seriously. We treat your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the statutory data protection regulations as well as this privacy policy.

The use of our website is generally possible without providing personal data. Where personal data (e.g. name, email address, telephone number) is collected on our pages, this is always done, as far as possible, on a voluntary basis.

3. Collection and Storage of Personal Data and Type and Purpose of Use

a) When Visiting the Website

When you access our website, information is automatically sent by the browser of your device to the server of our website. This information is temporarily stored in what is called a log file. The following information is collected:

IP address of the requesting computer

Date and time of access

Name and URL of the file accessed

Website from which access is made (referrer URL)

Browser used and, if applicable, the operating system of your computer as well as the name of your access provider

This data is processed in order to ensure a smooth connection to the website, to evaluate the use of the website, and to ensure system

security and stability. The legal basis is Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR (legitimate interest).

b) When Using the Contact Form

If you send us inquiries via the contact form or by email, the information you provide, including the contact details you have entered, will be stored by us for the purpose of processing your inquiry and in case of follow-up questions.

The legal basis is Art. 6 (1) lit. b GDPR (contract performance or pre-contractual measures).

4. Disclosure of Data

Your personal data will only be transmitted to third parties if:

you have given your express consent (Art. 6 (1) lit. a GDPR),

the processing is necessary for the performance of a contract (Art. 6 (1) lit. b GDPR),

there is a legal obligation to do so (Art. 6 (1) lit. c GDPR), or

the transfer is necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims (Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR).

5. Cookies
